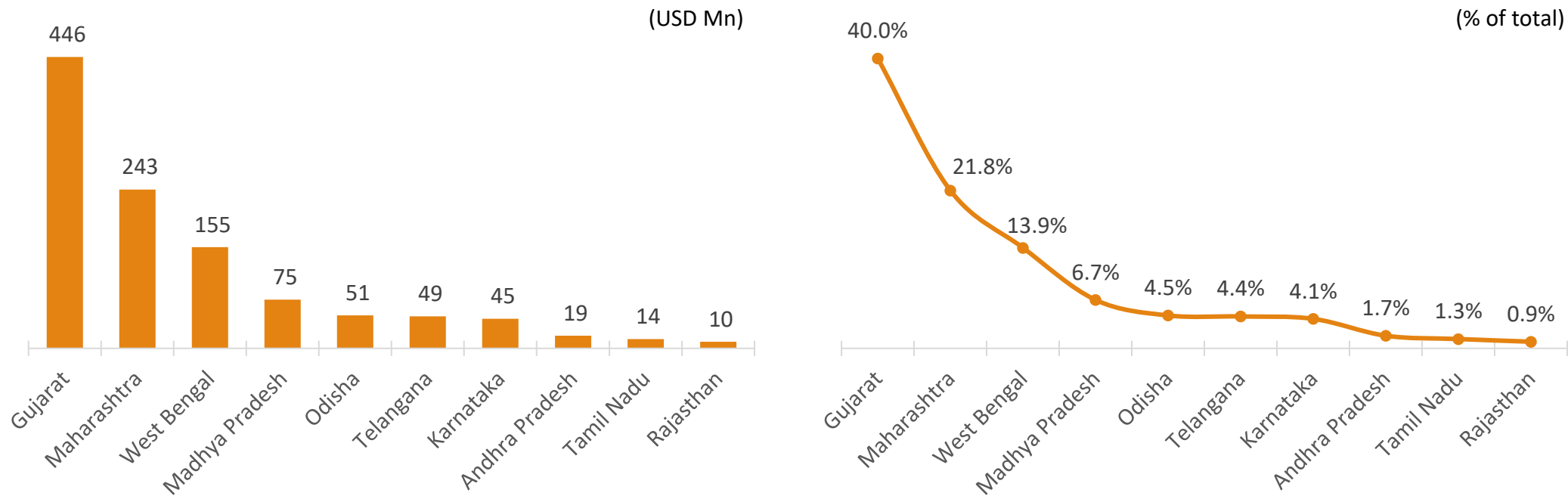

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DURING 2023-24



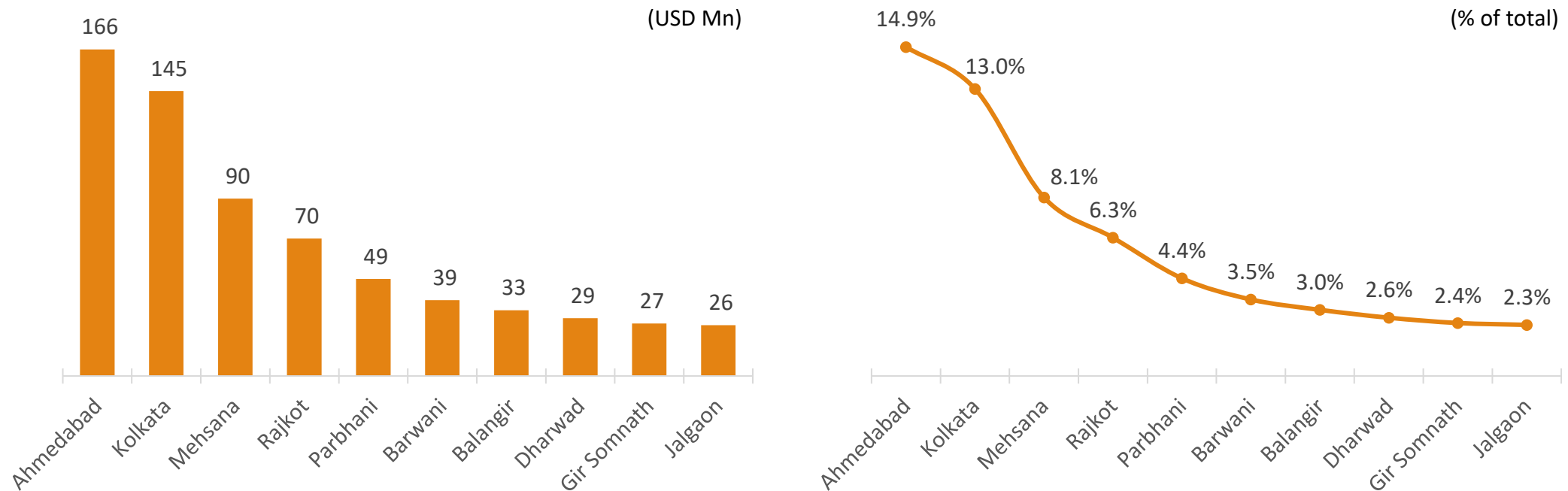
# Top-10 exporting states

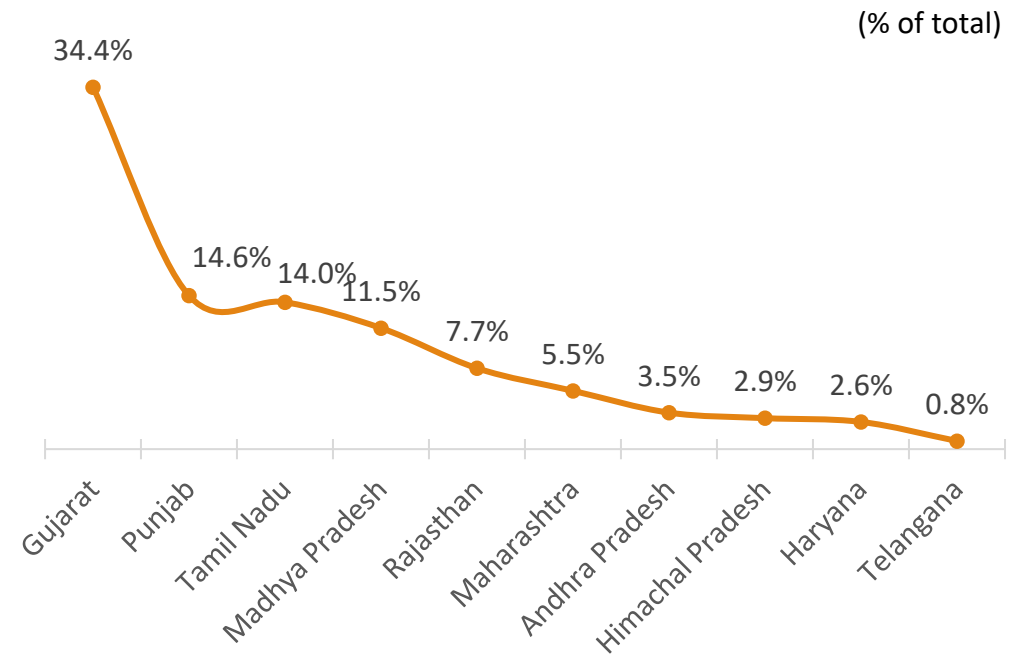

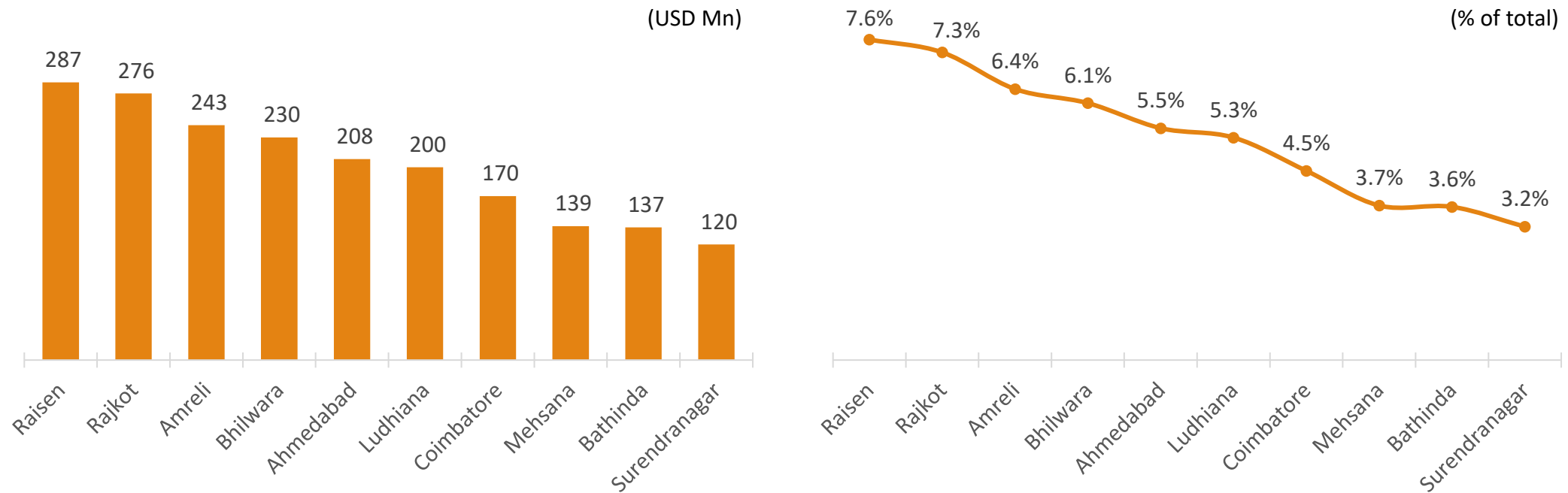

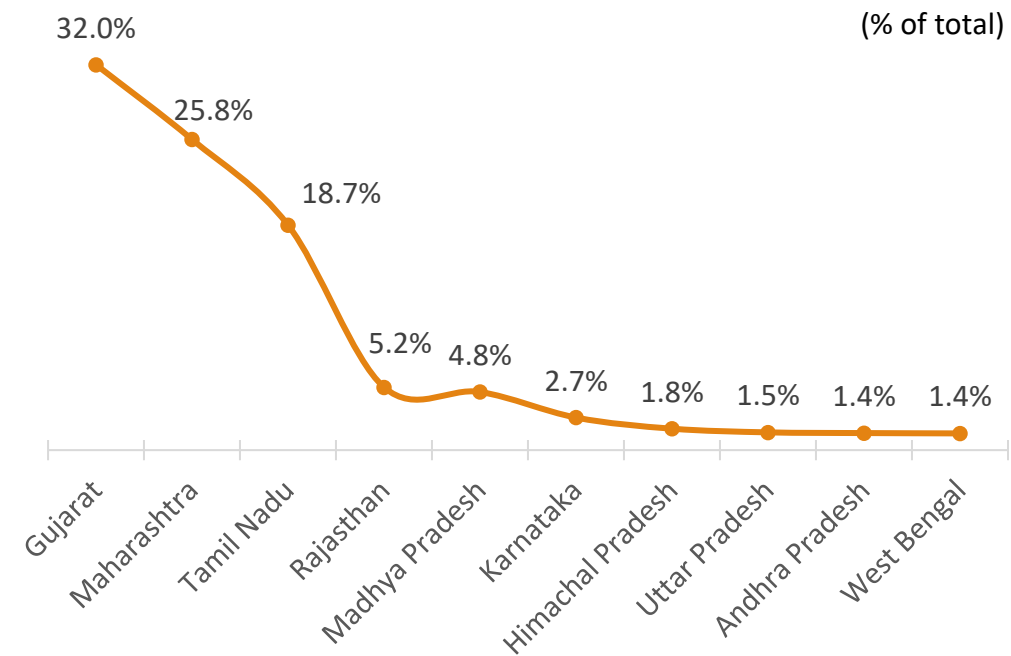
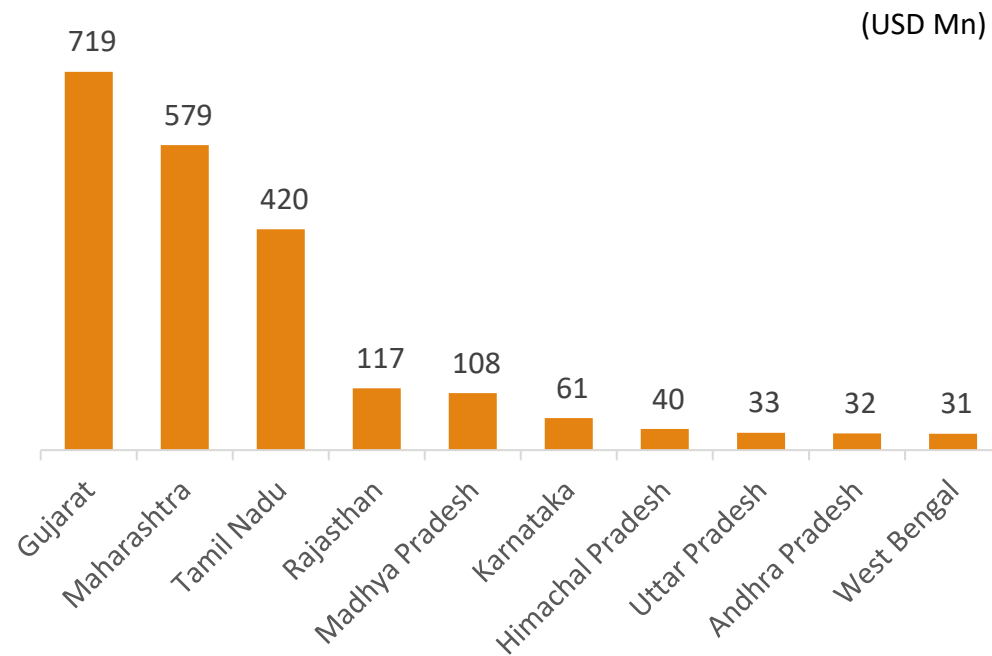
# Cotton Fabrics Exports

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DURING 2023-24



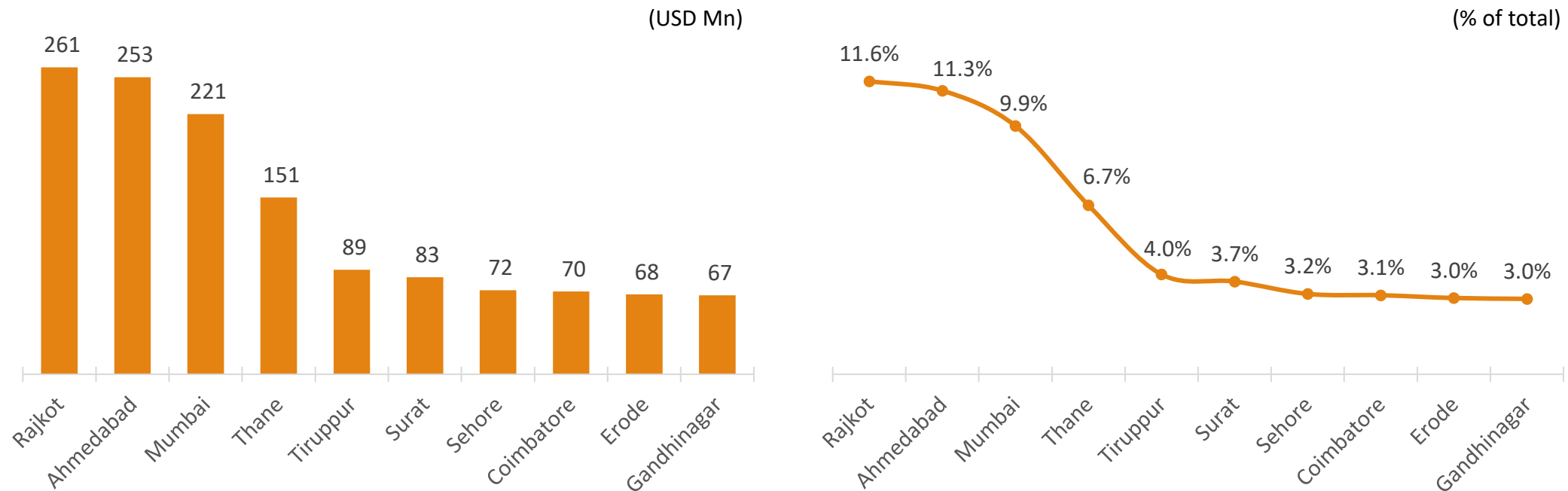

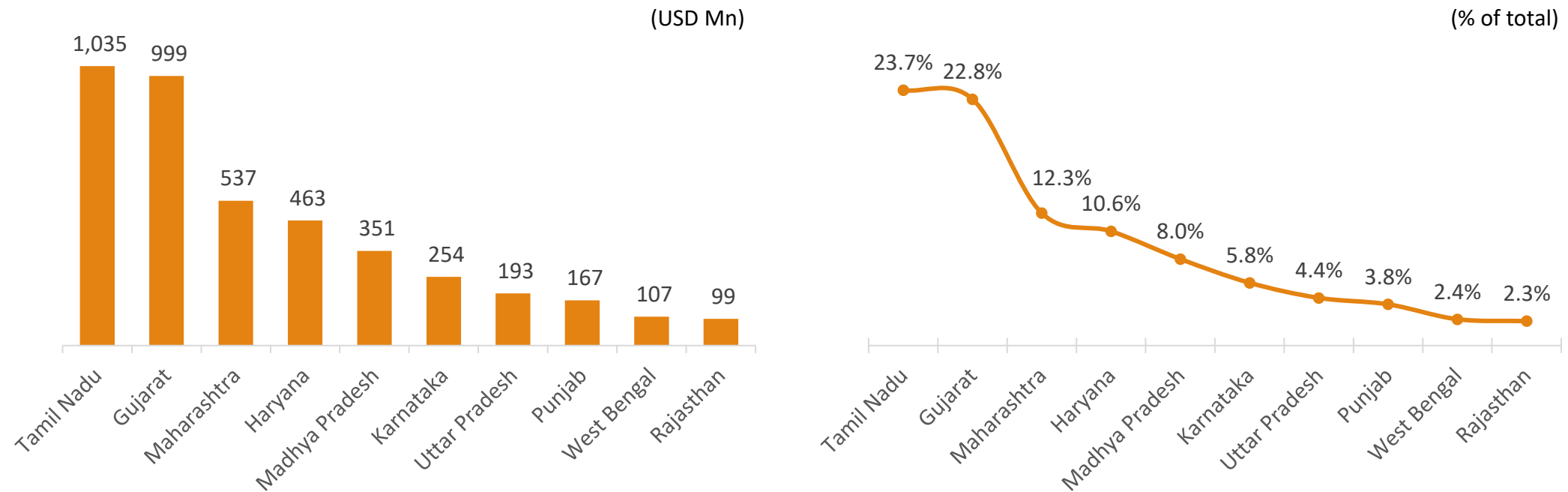

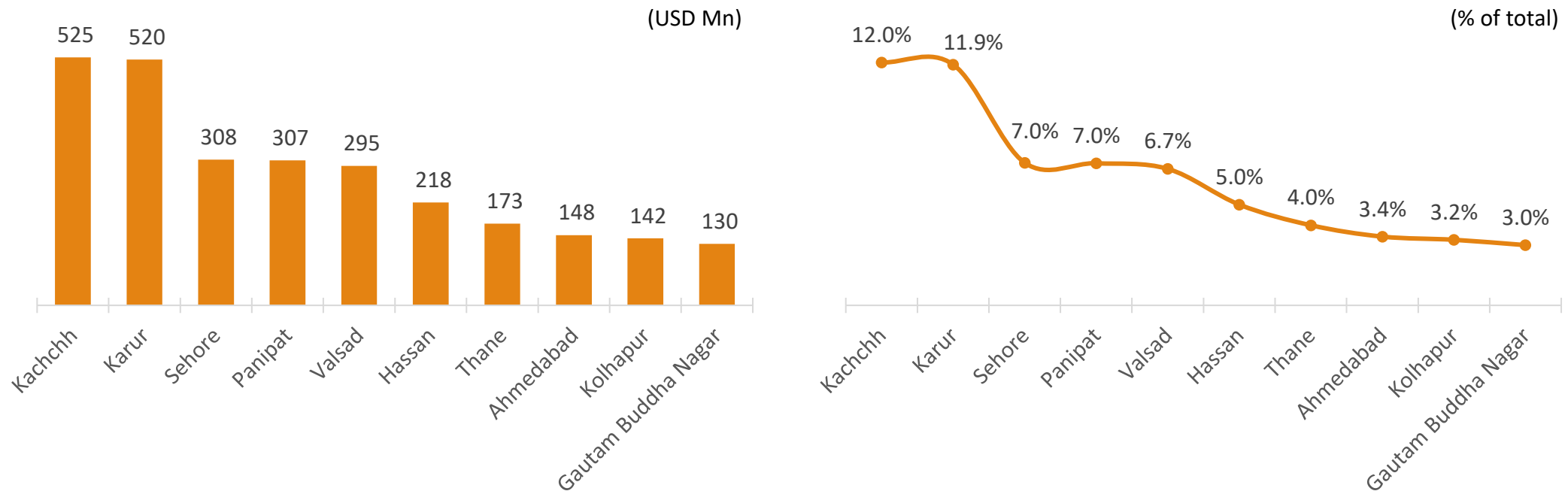

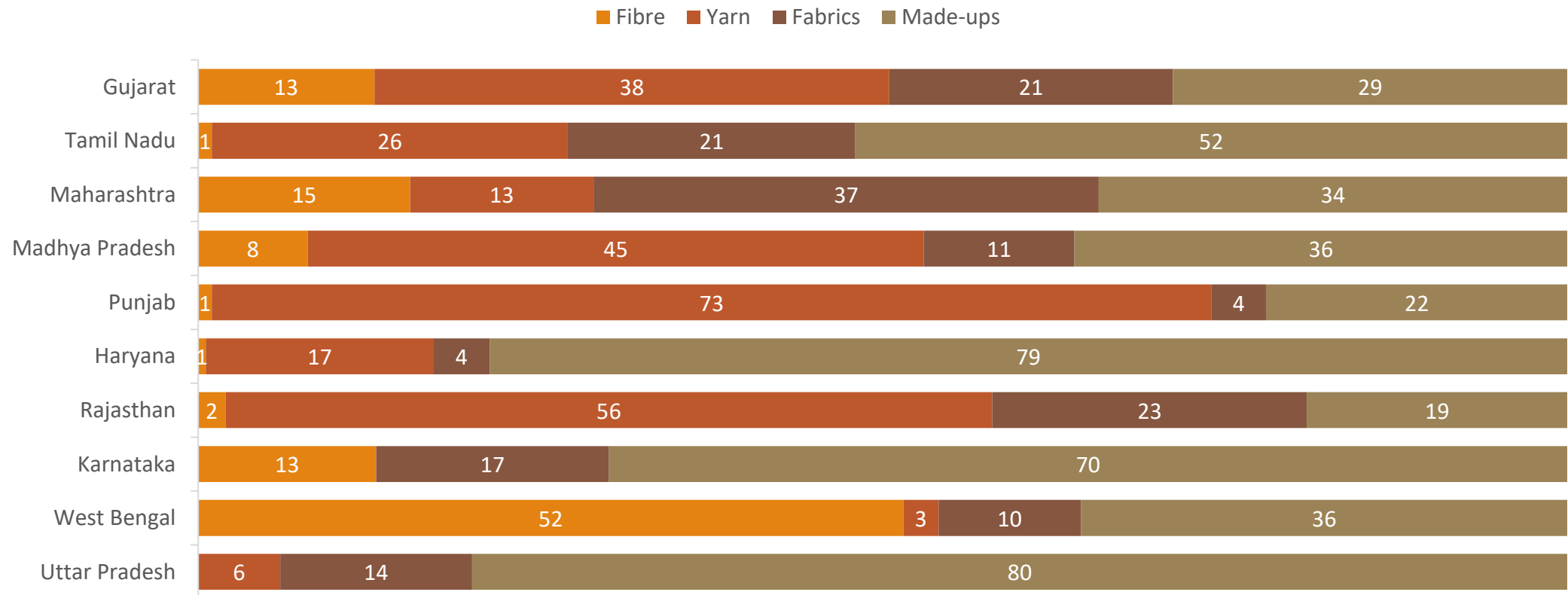
