Sub : Exports & Imports allowed without furnishing bonds to the Customs

Dear Member,

The Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) has issued Circular No. 09/2021-Customs dated May 8, 2021 to allow imports and exports of goods without furnishing bonds to the customs authorities until June 30, 2021. This measure is to ensure that there are no delay or disruption in EXIM trade due to COVID-19 and the lockdown/constraints imposed in different regions of India.

According to the Circular, importers and exporters will have to furnish an undertaking to the Customs authorities in lieu of the bonds **till June 30, 2021**.

Further, Importers/Exporters availing this facility are required to replace the undertaking furnished in lieu of bond with a proper bond **by July 15, 2021**.
