Sub : Inviting comments/suggestions on draft technical regulations for Cotton Yarn and Cotton Fabrics

Dear Member,

As you may be aware, the Central Government has been regularly framing Technical Regulations (TR) / Quality Control Orders (QCO), and minimum quality standards for the products manufactured by the domestic industry or imported by any Indian company. These regulations ensure that the products manufactured meet the required norms and parameters thereby enhancing final quality of the product.

In an effort to formulate and streamline the minimum BIS technical standards for 47 textile products, four Working Groups have been formed under the Chairmanship of Shri. Ajit B. Chavan, Secretary and CEO, Textiles Committee, Ministry of Textiles, Government of India.

The Working Group on Cotton and Cotton Textiles had its first meeting on 27th October 2021 through Video Conferencing wherein detailed presentations were made on the Indian Standards by the Textiles Committee for the following cotton textile products:

No. Product Description Indian Standard (IS)

1. Textiles - Ring Spun Grey Cotton Yarn for Hosiery IS 834:2006
2. Textiles - Ring Spun Grey Cotton Yarn IS 13683:2006
3. Cotton Cellular Shirting IS 1144:1980

After detailed discussion, it was decided to invite comments/suggestions from the Working Group members within a time frame of two weeks.

The entire process in preparing the draft Technical Regulations is very important and significant because once it is approved by the Government, it will be made mandatory for the products manufactured by the domestic industry as well as for imports.

We request the members to kindly send your comments/suggestions, if any, by return email to the Council at shailesh@texprocil.org / mrunal@texprocil.org with justification latest by 10th November 2021 as this will help us consolidate the inputs and submit to the Working Group for consideration and finalisation of draft recommendations on the Technical Regulations.
