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<u>Sub: Inviting participation at the Buyer-Seller Meet (BSM) in Bangkok, Thailand – 10th April 2023</u>

Dear Member,

This is to inform you that the Council along with the support of Embassy of India in Bangkok, Thailand is organizing an exclusive BSM for Cotton Textiles on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2023 at the Hotel Holiday Inn immediately after the Council's participation at the SaigonTex in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam from 5<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> April 2023.

Textile Industry-Thailand

Thailand is the fourth largest trading destination for India in the ASEAN region and bilateral trade between India and Thailand reached an all-time high of around \$15 billion in 2021-22.

Analysis of Textiles & Clothing, Cotton Textiles, Cotton Yarns, Cotton Fabrics and Raw Cotton during the year 2021 is given below:

- -- In 2021, Thailand imported T&C worth US\$ 5,058 million from the world and US\$ 151 million from India with a share of 2.99%. The top 5 sourcing countries of T&C import were from China, Vietnam, Japan, Taiwan and USA.
- -- Thailand imported US\$ 3,997million worth of textiles from the world of which US\$ 1304 million were cotton based and the balance US\$ 356 million were of MMF / other fibres. Thailand imported US\$ 73 million worth of cotton textiles from India with a share of 6%. India is ranked fourth after Japan as the leading cotton textile suppliers to Thailand.
- -- Thailand imported US\$ 93 million worth of yarns from the world of which US\$ 28 million worth of cotton yarns from India with a share of 30%. India ranks first in supplying cotton yarns to Thailand.
- -- Thailand imported US\$ 781 million worth of Fabrics from the world of which US\$ 38 million worth of cotton Fabrics from India with a share of 5%. India ranks fourth in supplying cotton Fabrics to Thailand.
