Sub : Amendment in Circular for allowing transshipment of Bangladesh export goods to third countries through Delhi Air Cargo

Dear Member,

CBIC has issued Circular No.3/2023-Customs dated 7th February, 2023 ([copy enclosed](#)) by making amendments in Circular No.29/2020-Customs dated 22nd June, 2020 ([copy enclosed](#)) for allowing transshipment of Bangladesh export cargo to third countries through Delhi Air Cargo.

As you may be aware, the goods loaded on containers/ closed bodied trucks enter India from LCS Petrapole, move by road to Kolkata Air Cargo, from where they are airlifted and transported to third countries. It has now been represented to allow this movement through Delhi Air Cargo also, for better cargo evacuation and improved logistics efficiency.

In this regard, a new paragraph, i.e. Para 3A has been inserted after sub-paragraph 3.2 of Circular No.29/2020-Customs dated 22nd June, 2020:

"3A. Transshipment of goods by road from LCS Petrapole to Air Cargo Complex, Delhi is also allowed with effect from 15.02.2023 following the procedure prescribed in the aforesaid Circular, until further direction from the Board."

Members may kindly take a note of the above.
