Sub: (i) Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment (Third Amendment) Regulations, 2024 and (ii) Implementation of the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transshipment Regulations (SCMTR)

Dear Member,

CBIC has issued Notification No. 57/2024-Customs (N.T.) on 31st August, 2024 (enclosed), by making Third amendments to the Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations (SCMTR), 2018 called as Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations (SCMTR), 2024. The Board has implemented SCMTR in a phased manner at Ports mentioned in the Table of the Notification.

CBIC has also issued Circular No.12/2024-Customs dated 31st August, 2024 (enclosed) on implementation of Sea Cargo Manifest and Transhipment Regulations (SCMTR).

- -- The SCMTR seeks to bring about transparency, predictability of movement, advance collection of information for expeditious risk-based Customs clearance.
- -- The regulations stipulate the obligations, the roles and responsibilities for various stakeholders involved in the movement of imported/exported goods.
- -- The regulations also specify the changes to the formats and timelines for filing the manifest declarations.
