As a part of the export promotion activities for the year 2024-25, the Council is mobilising participation in Vietnam International Trade Fair for Apparel, Textiles and Textile Technologies (VIATT25) in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam from 26th to 28th February 2025 at the Saigon Exhibition and Convention Centre (SECC) with the support of Consulate General of India in Ho Chi Minh City.

Vietnam International Trade Fair for Apparel, Textiles and Textile Technologies (VIATT25) is organised by Messe Frankfurt (HK) Ltd. and the Vietnam Trade Promotion Agency (VIETRADE) covering the entire textile industry value chain.

Why Participate?

Hence, this is a good opportunity for textile enterprises of India to display and introduce their products and raw materials such as yarns, fibres and fabrics for casualwear, sportswear and uniforms, as well as garment accessories which is in high

demand in the domestic market. This will enable Vietnamese buyers to meet, exchange and understand the requirement for business cooperation and production development.

Trade Data

After navigating the challenges of 2023, Vietnam's textile and garment exports have been gradually recovering. Additionally, foreign direct investment (FDI) into Vietnam during the first five months of this year reached USD 11 billion, a 2% year-on-year increase, according to the Foreign Investment Agency under the Ministry of Planning and Investment (MPI).

In Q1, 2024, textile and garment exports grew 6.3% year-on-year to over USD 10 billion. The US remains Vietnam's top export market, followed by the EU, South Korea, China and Japan. To meet this demand, Vietnam's textile industry continues to import a significant amount of raw materials.

Vietnam's home textile market is projected to undergo a steady CAGR of 2.4% from 2024-2032, driven by the rising need for modern and stylish home textiles, ecommerce expansion, and favourable government initiatives.

Participation Fees:

The participation fees for a booth of 9 sq.mtrs. is Rs.3,15,000 as per the Organisers cost.

However, the Council is offering a booth of 9 sq.mtrs. at a subsidised rate of Rs.1,92,700 as follows:

1) Participation fees: Rs.1,75,000

2) Administration fees: Rs.15,000 + 18% GST (Rs.2,700) = Rs.17,700

The total participation fees is Rs.1,75,000 + Rs.17,700 = Rs.1,92,700

Participants are requested to make two separate payments of Rs.1,75,000 & Rs.17,700 towards participation fees and administration fees. The Council will issue two separate Invoices.

Standard built up Booth:

3 lights, 1 Power point Socket, 1 Square Table, 3 Chairs, 4 Shelves (1mLx0.3mW) / Fabrics Rod(1mL), 1 lockable cabinet, 1 Waste basket, Special fascia design for India Pavilion.

Please note that this fee does not include Airfare, Hotel expenditure, sending display material and other related expenditure. The participation charges are refundable only in case of cancellation of trade fair by the fair organizer, if any.
