<u>Sub: Inviting participation at the Virtual Buyer Seller Meet (BSM with importers</u> <u>from Guatemala on 13th December 2024</u>

Dear Member,

The Council along with Embassy of India in Guatemala, is organising a virtual BSM between Indian exporters and importers from Guatemala on 13th December 2024, from 8 p.m. onwards (India Time)/8.25 a.m. (Guatemalean time).

The online Buyer Seller Meet (BSM) is being organised with support and guidance from the Embassy of India in Guatemala City This is a focused BSM where around 50 companies in garments, clothing and textiles will be participating in the B2B session. (list of interested companies attached)

Highlights of the market for Cotton Textiles in Guatemala are presented below:

Guatemala imported USD 778 million of Cotton Textiles in 2023. The largest share (33%) of imports in cotton textiles by Guatemala is for made ups – USD 257 million, followed by yarns (32%) amounting to USD 255 million; cotton fabrics (22%) worth USD 168 million; and cotton fibre (13%) worth USD 98 million.

While India has a market share of 12% and 13% in the import of cotton fabrics and cotton yarn, respectively, there is a huge opportunity in cotton made-ups since our market share in this segment is just 0.4%. Guatemala has been primarily sourcing cotton made-ups from the USA.
