<u>Sub: DGFT seeks comments on proposal to make GST E-Invoices received</u> <u>through GSTN to DGFT BO portal mandatory for claiming Deemed Export</u> <u>Benefits under FTP pursuant to the provisions of Para 1.07A and B of FTP 2023</u>

DGFT vide Trade Notice No.35/2024-25 dated 25.03.2025 (<u>enclosed</u>) is integrating with the Goods and Services Tax Network (GSTN) to enhance data exchange and improve transparency.

As part of this initiative, it is proposed to make GST e-invoices and returns filed on GSTN, to be utilised in various contexts, including validation of electronic Bank Realization Certificates (eBRCs) and verification of deemed export transactions on the DGFT BO portal mandatory
