

Sub: Webinar on Navigating Trade Barriers: "Implications of Bangladesh's Import Restrictions on Indian Yarn via Land Ports"

Dear Member,

The National Board of Revenue, Customs Wing has issued a notification on 13th April 2025 restricting imports of all types of yarn from India using the land port. Bangladesh is India's 2nd largest trade partner for cotton textile products and this notification plus other challenges in exports to Bangladesh can disrupt India's yarn exports to Bangladesh.

In this regard, the Council in association with The Southern Indian Mills Association (SIMA) is organizing a webinar on Thursday, 24th April 2025 at 3.00 p.m. to analyse the situation and discuss the way forward.

The Council will share insights on the situation to help companies navigate the Trade Barriers effectively. Members are requested to participate in the session in order to seek clarifications as well as provide valuable inputs for the benefit of the Indian Spinning sector.
