Dear Member,

The Cotton Textiles Export Promotion Council is organizing National Level Participation in 'Egypt Fabric & Yarn / Egy Stich & Tex Show' held at Cairo international Convention Centre (CICC) from 4th to 7th December 2025. The Fabric & Yarn exhibition is held concurrently with the 18th edition of Egy Stitch & Tex, a show focused on Textile & Garments. The Show also includes machinery and technology related to T&C industry.

EGYPT FABRIC & YARN

This is the only event in Egypt dedicated to the entire textile and apparel manufacturing value chain. As a key player in apparel production and exports, Egypt hosts this show to serve the needs of garment and home textile manufacturers seeking raw materials such as yarns, fibres, fabrics, narrow weaves, linings, dyes, inks, printing solutions, and the latest in textile and garment machinery and technology.

Egypt is an important market for India considering India is the largest cotton yarn exporter to this country. Demand for yarns is expected to grow by 19% over the next 3 years.

In addition to the Free Trade Agreements with European Union, COMESA and Arab World, Egypt's qualifying industrial zone (QIZ) agreement with the United States gives local manufacturers both tariff and quota-free access to the US market.

Egypt's commercial ports and strategic location allow the companies to access Asia, Africa and Europe easily.

Why Egypt Fabric & Yarn:

• Textiles is the largest industry in the Egyptian economy which is predominantly cotton based.

• India being the largest cotton yarn exporter to Egypt, this is the go-to show for the entire textile manufacturing value chain.

• Yarns & Fabrics have a dedicated hall and Indian exhibitors get the platform to showcase their products among fashion and finished goods exhibitors.

• Visitors to this show are predominantly from the textile and garment manufacturing companies looking for yarns, textiles, fabrics, latest in machinery, technology, inks, dyes, etc.

<u>Trade Data</u>

In 2024, Egypt imported Textile & Clothing worth USD 4218 million of which imports from India were USD 314 with a share of 8%. India is a 3rd largest supplier after China & Turkey.

Egypt imported cotton textiles worth USD 677 million and cotton yarn worth USD 327 million from the world. India is the largest supplier of cotton textiles and cotton yarn with USD 171.92, a share of 25.40% and USD 151.56, a share of 46.40% respectively.
