Sub: Digital Stamping and Execution of Single Unified Multi-Purpose Electronic Bond in Customs – “Ekal Anubandh”

Dear Member,

This is to inform you that the Office of the Commissioner of Customs (NS-III), Jawaharlal Nehru Custom House, has issued Public Notice No. 01/2026 dated 2nd January 2026 ([copy enclosed](#)) regarding the introduction of a Single Unified Multi-Purpose Electronic Bond (SEB) under the “Ekal Anubandh” initiative.

Under this initiative, importers and exporters will have the option to execute a single, all-India, multi-purpose electronic bond in lieu of multiple transaction-wise bonds presently required for various purposes such as provisional assessment, export promotion schemes, warehousing, MOOWR, etc.

Key features of the Ekal Anubandh system include:

- One-time execution of a common electronic bond through ICEGATE
- Electronic payment of stamp duty and digital execution of bond through NeSL
- Online linkage and verification of Electronic Bank Guarantee (e-BG)
- Facility to add additional obligations or enhance bond value at a later stage

It is further informed that:

- The e-Bond facility has been operational in Maharashtra since 03.10.2025
- Manual bonds and bank guarantees will be discontinued at JNCH with effect from the end of the day on 31.01.2026
- Acceptance of Single Unified Multi-Purpose Electronic Bond (SEB) in electronic form only will be mandatory from 01.02.2026

Members are advised to familiarize themselves with the procedures prescribed in CBIC Circular No. 04/2025-Customs dated 17.02.2025 and ensure timely migration to the electronic bond system to avoid any disruption in Customs clearances.
