Sub.: TUFS - JITs for ongoing subsidy accounts of previous version

Dear Member,

Kindly refer to TEXPROCIL Circular No. EPS/Cir/24/2019-20 dated August 23, 2019 on the above subject.

As per Public Notice dated 25.7.2019 issued by the office of the Textile Commissioner, a system has been put in place for the physical verification of machinery under the previous versions of the TUF Scheme (MTUFS / RTUFS / RRTUFS). This verification system will be applicable on a First Come First Out (FIFO) in all those cases where the claims have been submitted by Banks / Lending agencies through online software to the office of the Textile Commissioner. A Joint Inspection Team (JIT) constituted on similar lines as in the case of ATUFS will physically verify the machinery procured and other documents. The verification by JIT will be carried out in those cases where Banks / Lending agencies have submitted the claims of the units through online to the office of the Textile Commissioner.

Banks / Lending agencies who have sanctioned /disbursed term loan under TUFS to the beneficiaries are required to upload six prescribed documents scheme-wise and unit-wise in the window under i-TUFS software for conduct of inspection by JIT on FIFO basis.

The office of the Textile Commissioner has now issued a Status Report copy enclosed

(click here) on the progress of physical verification of accounts in terms of the above

Public Notice. According to this Report, only 151 cases have been processed by the

banks out of 3399 applications received.

In this regard, the office of the Textile Commissioner has also issued a D.O. letter

dated 5.9.2019 instructing all Banks / Lending Agencies to ensure the following;

(1) To lodge subsidy claims online for the remaining accounts by September 15, 2019.

(2) Upload all the prescribed six documents by September 30, 2019.

(3) Completion of task for updating / entering the committed liability for the

remaining cases under MTUFS List I by September 30, 2019 by 6.00 p.m.

(4) Completion of task of forwarding committed liability for the remaining cases under

MTUFS List II in excel sheet to the office of the Textile commissioner by September 30,

2019 by 6.00 p.m.

A copy of the above D.O. letter is enclosed herewith (click here).

Please note that the office of the Textile Commissioner has clarified that the

window for uploading of documents in the i-TUFS will not be kept open

indefinitely.

In view of the above, we would once again request you to kindly to please approach

your Bank / Lending agency(ies) for expediting the uploading of the documents on the

i-TUFS software, in case you have pending claims under the MTUFS, RTUFS and

RRTUFS, so that the Regional office of the Textile Commissioner can initiate the JIT

verification process on a FIFO basis.
