Sub: Samples of Home textiles products from South Korea

Dear Member,

As part of its strategy to diversify exports of Home textiles into new markets, the Council is focusing on South Korea as an important market.

As you may be aware, there is zero duty on import of fabrics and made ups (including home textiles) from India into South Korea under the Indo-Korea CEPA.

There is good potential to increase exports of fabrics and home textiles products from India to South Korea. The awareness of the South Korean buyers about the capacity of Indian textiles sector to supply high quality products is increasing. However, there are some challenges in exporting to South Korea which need to be overcome. The Council will provide all kinds of guidance and assistance to the members in exporting to South Korea.

In this regard, the Council has got samples of home textiles products and fabrics from South Korea.

These samples are displayed at the Council's Trade Centre at its office in Mumbai.

Interested members can visit the Council's office to examine the samples every week on **Wednesday and Friday between 3.00 p.m. to 5.00 p.m.** This will enable the members to understand the requirement of the South Korean buyers.
