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Sub: O/o Textiles Committee invites inputs on proposed mandatory labelling for garments and made-ups sold in India

Dear Member,

This is to inform you that O/o Textiles Committee held a stakeholder consultation meeting on 04.12.2025 to discuss the proposed mandatory labelling regulations for Ready-Made Garments and Made-ups sold in India.

Purpose of the proposed regulations

- To ensure that every garment and made-up sold in India carries essential information such as fibre composition, country of origin and wash & care instructions, so that consumers get accurate information before buying, know exactly what they are purchasing and are protected from misleading claims.
- To match India's labelling rules with global standards followed in developed countries, where display of the essential information is already compulsory.
- Labels and markings will help recycle used textile products by showing their fibre composition.
