Sub: "Onboarding of CDSCO, WCCB, Textile Committee, and MeitY on SWIFT 2.0 as Single Touch Point for Trade."

Dear Member,

This is to inform you that Office of the Principal Commissioner of Customs (Air Cargo), Chennai has issued a Public Notice No. 05/2026 dated 04-02-2026 ([copy enclosed](#)) regarding onboarding of Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO), Wildlife Crime Control Bureau (WCCB), Textile Committee, and The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) on SWIFT 2.0 as a single touchpoint for trade.

In this connection, CBIC has also issued Circular No. 05/2026 dated 01.02.2026 ([copy enclosed](#)), which refers to the earlier Circular No. 29/2025 dated 21.11.2025 ([copy enclosed](#)) and explains its implementation in the present context.

Below are the key highlights:

SWIFT 2.0 Expansion:

- SWIFT 2.0 aims to integrate over 60 Partner Government Agencies (PGAs) in phases to streamline EXIM clearances.
- Animal Quarantine and Certification Services (AQCS), Plant Quarantine Management System (PQMS), and Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) were onboarded in the first phase on a pilot basis.
- CDSCO, WCCB, MeitY, and Textile Committee are now integrated into SWIFT 2.0.

Unified Applications:

- Unified applications for AQCS, PQMS, and FSSAI are live for NOC processing at designated ports.
- CDSCO and WCCB unified applications are now available for NOC processing.

Digital Integration:

- Certificates issued by MeitY (CCDC and CRO exemption certificates) and Textile Committee (test reports) are digitally integrated with the Bill of Entry for validation and record-keeping, eliminating the need for physical submission.

Collocation of PGA Officers:

-- Officers from AQCS, CDSCO, and WCCB are now collocated onto Indian Customs IT infrastructure under SWIFT 2.0, reducing the need for separate document submissions.

Document Codes for LPCOs/NOCs:

Specific document codes have been assigned to Licences, Permits, Certificates, and Other Documents (LPCOs/NOCs) issued by PGAs, detailed in Annexures C, D, and E.

Stakeholder Feedback:

-- The functionalities of SWIFT 2.0 will initially be operational for feedback before mandatory rollout.

-- Complete integration of five PGAs (FSSAI, AQCS, PQMS, WCCB, and CDSCO) under SWIFT 2.0 is targeted by 31st March 2026, with all PGAs onboarded by 31st March 2027.

Field Formations:

-- Field formations are instructed to issue Public Notices/Trade Notices to inform stakeholders about the changes and ensure proper filing of data and documents under SWIFT 2.0.
