Sub: Launch of Facilitating Logistics Interventions for Freight & Transport (LIFT) under Export Promotion Mission (EPM) – NIRYAT DISHA

Dear Member,

This is to inform you that DGFT has introduced a new scheme titled Support for Logistics Interventions for Freight & Transport (LIFT) under the Export Promotion Mission (EPM – Niryat Disha) with immediate effect vide Trade Notice No. 29/2025-26 dated 20th February 2026 ([copy enclosed](#)).

The objective of this scheme is to support MSME exporters located in regions with low export activity and higher logistics challenges. The initiative aims to reduce freight and transport costs arising due to geographical disadvantages and logistics gaps faced by exporters in such areas.

The Trade Notice provides detailed information in the following annexures:

- Annexure III – Governance Structure
- Annexure IV – Application Procedure

The scheme will initially be implemented on a pilot basis to gather feedback, enable institutional learning, and allow improvements based on experience.
