Sub: Amendment to Customs (Electronic Cash Ledger) Regulations, 2022

Dear Madam / Sir,

This is to inform you that the Government of India, Ministry of Finance (Department of Revenue) has issued Notification No. 30/2026-Customs (N.T.) dated 24th March 2026, amending the Customs (Electronic Cash Ledger) Regulations, 2022 ([click here](#)).

The key amendments are as follows:

1) Introduction of Payment Aggregator Mode:

-- A new clause has been inserted in Regulation 3(6) to allow payments through payment aggregators.

2) Expansion of Payment Modes:

-- In Regulation 3(7), the existing provision has been expanded to include payments made through payment aggregators, in addition to internet banking via authorised banks.

3) Effective Date:

-- The amendment will come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

Implication for Members: The amendment facilitates an additional digital payment option for deposits in the Electronic Cash Ledger, thereby enhancing ease of doing business and offering greater flexibility in payment methods.

Members are advised to take note of the above changes.
