Sub: Invitation to participate in the 18th edition of Intex South Asia Show to be held at Dhaka, Bangladesh from 18th to 20th June 2026

We are pleased to inform you that the Council is organizing participation in the 18th Intex South Asia Show to be held in Hall 2, ICCB, Dhaka, Bangladesh from 18th to 20th June 2026.

Event details are as under:

Dates: 18th to 20th June 2026

Venue: Hall 2, International Convention City, Bashundhara (ICCB), Purbhachal Express Highway, Dhaka.

Having connected 68,000+ trade buyers from over 40 countries to 2,875+ textile suppliers over the last 17 editions, it has empowered industry players to explore new business opportunities, forge worldwide connections and stay up-to-date with latest developments making Intex South Asia the annual calendar event for South Asia's Textile & Apparel industry.

Why should you participate in the Intex South Asia Show, Bangladesh?

- Despite the ongoing issues, Bangladesh continues to remain among the top 3 suppliers of garments in the world and supplies to more than 200 countries.
- RMG exports from Bangladesh has grown from USD 4 billion in 2001 to USD 39 billion in 2024-25 commanding a market share of 6.9% of the total exports globally.
- Bangladesh imported USD 18.4 billion of raw material from the world in FY 2024-25, and increase of 10% from the previous year, 98% of which is fibre, yarn and fabrics. Yarn imports surged by 39%, while imports of woven & knit fabrics increased by nearly 30%.
- Of these imports of cotton textile products is around 33%.
- Exclusive India Pavilion for Indian exhibitors at the fair with facility for a VIP Lounge for one-to-one meetings.

India's exports to Bangladesh have grown by more than 20% in FY 2024-25 as compared to the previous year. The Council had invited nearly 70 leading companies from Bangladesh for Bharat Tex 2025. Intex South Asia would be an excellent opportunity to connect with them and others once again.

#### Participation Fees

All member exporters of TEXPROCIL and other EPCs shall be eligible to participate by paying a discounted rate of Rs. 1,38,500 along with an administrative fee of Rs. 15,400 + 18% GST (Rs.2,772) = 18,172 for a 9 sqm booth.

Two separate invoices will be raised and payment has to be made separately

1. Rs. 1,38,500 for 9 sqm. For Shell scheme booth
2. Administrative fee of Rs. 15,400 + 18% GST = 18,172 /-

Since there are limited corner booths, allotment of corner booth will be on a 'First Come First Serve' basis against application and full payment. There is a surcharge of 10% for corner booths.

Similar to the regular booth two separate invoices will be raised for separate payments.

1. Rs. 1,52,350 for 9 sqm corner shell scheme booth
2. Administrative fee of Rs. 16,940 + 18% GST (Rs. 3,049) = 19,989/-

The charges cover standard booth facilities of Needle Punch Carpet, 3 Sides System Panel, 1 Fascia, 1 Reception Desk, 1 Round Table, 3 Chairs, 3 Spotlights of 100W, 1 Power Socket and 1 Waste Basket. Yarn exporters will be provided 2 yarn shelves per 9 sqm booth while fabric exporters will be provided 2 fabric hangars per 9 sqm booth. Additional shelves/hangars will be charged extra.

Please note that this fee does not include Airfare, Hotel expenditure, dispatch of

display material and other related expenditure.

The participation charges are refundable only in case of cancellation of trade fair by the fair organizer.

No change in the booths, once allotted would be entertained under any circumstances.

In case of dispute, the decision of TEXPROCIL will be final.

Note: The Council has proposed participation of the event under the Market Access Support Scheme under Export Promotion Mission, however, we have not yet received approval for this event. In case the approval is granted subsequently, the applicable subsidy will be provided to the 20 eligible applicants on a 'First Come First Served' basis hence, please send your applications with entire participation fee immediately.
