Sub: Amendment in Para 9.05 of FTP 2023 – Removal of Per-Consignment Value Limit for Courier Exports

Dear Madam / Sir,

DGFT has issued Notification No. 67/2025-26 dated 27th March 2026 ([copy enclosed](#)) by amending Para 9.05 of the Foreign Trade Policy 2023. The amendment comes into force from 1st April 2026.

Key Amendment:

The earlier provision prescribing a value limit of Rs.10,00,000 per consignment for exports through courier service has been withdrawn.

i.e When exporting goods through courier mode (like DHL, FedEx, etc.), there was a maximum value limit of Rs.10,00,000 per consignment

So: If your shipment value exceeded Rs.10 lakh,

- You could not use courier mode
- ✓ You had to use regular cargo/shipping

As per the revised provision, there shall be no value limit per consignment for exports through courier service/post.

So now: There is NO upper value limit for exports through courier

You can export: ✓ Even high-value shipments via courier

Effect of the Notification:

- The removal of the value limit will facilitate exporters by enabling shipment of higher-value consignments through courier mode.
- This will enhance ease of doing business and promote faster export logistics, especially for high-value and time-sensitive shipments.

Members are advised to take note of the above change.
