Invitation SLCP Webinar for India

With this letter we warmly invite you to participate in the upcoming SLCP Webinar. In the webinar we aim to inform you about the Social & Labor Convergence Program (SLCP), and the benefits it can bring to facilities in India. We will provide details on how you can participate, and reserve ample room for questions.

Who are we?

The Social and Labor Convergence Program (SLCP) developed a Convergence Assessment Framework (CAF), aiming to improve working conditions in global supply chains by eliminating the need for multiple social compliance audits. The CAF can reduce the need for current audit methodologies by delivering one verified data set that can be used by standards and brands. Last year we launched operations in mainland China and Sri Lanka. Around 200 facilities participated in the process. This year we are starting operations in India, Taiwan, Mexico, Spain, Turkey, Mauritius, the United States and Indonesia (pilot with ILO/BetterWork) with an estimated 1,250 facilities. SLCP is driven by its 200+ signatories, including manufacturers, brands, agents, industry associations, service providers, governments, standards, and other non-profit organizations. The SLCP process provides the following benefits for facilities:

- Addresses audit fatigue by reducing the number of social audits
- Dives deeper to measure employment practices
- Redeploys resources towards improvement actions
- Fosters trust and collaboration through the SLCP Verification Process
